III. Course related Information

Students have 5 types of class module to choose from when coming to exchange at NCCU:

- 1. <u>Full-Time Mandarin Class ONLY:</u> students who choose this will have 3 hours of Mandarin class every day from Monday ~ Friday for 12 weeks each term(except 10 weeks for the Winter term). Students of this choice won't be able to register academic courses at any department except for auditing (sitting-in), but as "auditing students," they won't receive any credits or grades. Full-time Mandarin classes are available in Fall, Winter Spring and Summer term. Students for one semester exchange can take only one term of Full-time Mandarin and students for one academic year exchange can take up to three terms.
- 2. **Academic classes ONLY:** students who choose this domain will only focus on their academic classes, and most of them will take up to 15~18 credits (5~6 subjects) per semester.
- 3. Academic classes + Part-Time Mandarin Class: this will be an ideal choice for students who need to take credit-given academic courses but also want to learn some Mandarin during their study at NCCU. The Mandarin class will be a 3 credit course with 5 lecture hour class per week for 12~15 weeks (54 lecture hours in total).
- 1st Full-Time Mandarin Class ONLY + 2nd Academic Class
 ONLY (1st Three-month for One CLC term + 2nd One School
 Semester): this is only available for student exchanging for 1 year.
- 5. <u>1st Academic Class ONLY + 2nd Full-Time Mandarin Class</u>

 <u>ONLY (1st One School Semester + 2nd Three-month for One CLC term):</u> this is only available for student exchanging for 1 year.

Notice: No separate switching of Mandarin class type is allowed after students have chosen a course module in the application system.

Mandarin courses are only open to exchange students whose mother language is not Chinese. Thus, students with nationality of Macau, Hong Kong, China, and Taiwan are only eligible for "Academic Classes ONLY" module.
